



# Code of Conduct Guidelines

The University of North Texas Humanities UNTamed Summer Camp staff are looking forward to providing your child with a fun, memorable, and safe summer camp experience! Each camper has a responsibility to act in a way that assures a positive experience for all. Please read, understand, and sign this waiver form to acknowledge your commitment to maintaining a respectful and cooperative atmosphere.

## Behavior Guidelines:

### Respect for Others

- Treat everyone with kindness and respect. Bullying, harassment, or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Listen to camp leader and peers. Follow directions and maintain open communication.

### Safety First

- Follow all safety rules and guidelines. This includes staying within designated areas and using equipment properly.
- Report any unsafe conditions or incidents to a camp leader immediately.

### Participation and Attitude

- Engage in camp activities with a positive attitude. Be open to trying new things and participate to the best of your ability.
- Take responsibility for your actions. Be honest and accept the consequences of your behavior.

### Property and Equipment

- Respect camp property and equipment. Use items as intended and report any damage.
- Keep personal belongings secure. The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

## Prohibited Behaviors:

- Endangering the health and safety of themselves, other campers, and/or staff or volunteers.
- Stealing, damaging, or failing to care for University or personal property.
- Continual disruption of the program.
- Refusal to follow the behavior guidelines.
- Inappropriate physical contact.
- Using profanity or inappropriate language or displaying clothing or other personal items with offensive content.
- Bullying or acts of aggression or violence.
- Possession or use of illegal substances, tobacco, or alcohol.
- Possession of weapons - any object that may cause harm to another, or place another person in fear of his/her safety, may be considered a weapon.

## Disciplinary Procedures:

When a camp participant does not follow the Code of Conduct, we may take the following steps:

1. Staff will redirect the camper to more appropriate behavior.
2. The camper will be reminded of the behavior guidelines and camp rules, and a discussion will take place.
3. The Camp Director will be notified of the problem and will meet with the camper.
4. If the behavior persists, a parent will be notified of the problem.
5. If a problem persists and a child continues to disrupt the Camp program, the UNT Humanities Division reserves the right to suspend or remove the camper from camp. If this were to happen, the UNT Humanities Division will not grant a credit or refund for any camp payments.
