Requirements & Payment Schedule

Each of the undergraduate scholarships (except for the Veta Watson Percy) is paid in two installments (Fall and Spring). The following qualifications apply to all these scholarships.

1. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA on all college work completed *or* a total of 1000 on the SAT or 24 in English on the ACT for entering freshmen (The Robert and Marjorie Hirsch scholarship requires a minimum GPA of 2.5)
2. The continuation of all scholarships into the second semester is contingent upon maintaining a GPA of 3.0 in at least 12 semester hours of course work (15 for the Mohat) and making at least a grade of B in each English class.
3. The student must be enrolled at UNT, but does not have to be a Texas resident.

Application Checklist

All applicants must send their completed Undergraduate Scholarship Application to english@unt.edu and include the following to be considered:

- Transcripts (unofficial accepted for current students)
- Freshman applicants only: proof of SAT or ACT scores
- Cover letter describing any honors and activities (both academic and non-academic) that show your high level of responsibility and commitment to literary studies and / or writing. Letter should include specific examples.
- Whitten applicants only*: proof of native Texas residency, such as a birth certificate
- Sampley applicants only*: one piece of creative writing

- All materials should be sent as attachments in an email. PDF, Word Doc, and JPEGs are acceptable. *Please do not put your attachments in the body of the email.*
- Email completed forms with applicable materials (see checklist) to: english@unt.edu.
