Have at least a 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

Elements to be submitted in the application packet:

2. Copy of unofficial transcript - be sure that your declared major and/or minor in the target language is present on your transcript.
3. Signed and sealed recommendation form Spanish faculty member at UNT with whom you have taken at least one class.
4. Typed essay (300 words maximum) on your intent at the time of application to complete the Spanish degree program at UNT.
